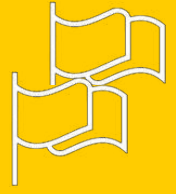

- Russian Language virtual course before the trip by ALAR Training Center (33h) + Certificate

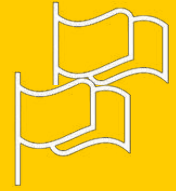
